Sunday, March 22nd, Start Time: 10:00 AM Warner Springs (Near Temecula)

RACE DESCRIPTION: Fast swoopy singletrack over rolling grassy hills. Riders will be doing multiple laps (approx 4.5 miles per lap), see below for lap counts. **Registration opens at 8:30 AM.** *All participants must be registered for the 2009 SoCal Interscholastic League Series. Register at <http://www.socaldirt.org>.* A late fee of \$20 applies for riders who are not FULLY registered for the series and race #2 (including payment and mail-in forms rec'v'd) by March 3rd.

PRE-RIDE: The course is open for pre-ride on Saturday and we recommend everyone pre-ride the course, both for safety and also as a good warm-up.

DIRECTIONS:

From Los Angeles - Approximately 2 1/2 hours

91 East to 15 South to Highway 79 South (not North), 38 miles to Warner Springs. Follow the signs!

From North San Diego County - Approximately 1 1/2 hours

78 East to the city of Escondido. 15 South to first exit on East Valley Parkway through Valley Center and Rincon Indian Reservation to Route 76 to Lake Henshaw. Left on Highway 79, then eight miles to Warner Springs.

From San Diego - Approximately 1 1/4 hours

North on Highway 15, exit at the Scripps Poway Parkway, go right. Turn left on Highway 67 which becomes Highway 78 in Ramona. Follow Highway 78 out of Ramona for about 15 miles to Dudley's Bakery in Santa Ysabel. Turn left on Highway 79. From Santa Ysabel it is 15 miles to Warner Springs Ranch on Highway 79.



ACCOMMODATIONS:

Stay overnight at the race venue! Two hundred and thirty four (234) cozy, early California-style casitas offer panoramic views of the Palomar Mountains and the surrounding foothills. All accommodations feature a rustic pine motif with either two double beds or a queen-sized bed. Some of the bungalows feature a fireplace to take the chill out of your bones and many offer refrigerators

Camping is also available at Warner Springs.

Check it out at www.warnersprings.com, or call at (760) 782-4200. When you make reservations be sure and tell them you are with the High School race to get a discount on rooms or camping.

FOOD SERVICE

There is a restaurant and snack bar within a mile of the race site.

MORE REGISTRATION INFO

1) If you registered for the 2009 Series (costs \$50) but did not register for Race #2, then you must register for Race #2 by paying the \$40 fee. There is a \$10 late fee for same day registration. Please pre-register at the Specialized Pitzone: <http://www.socaldirt.org/index.php> **-OR-** mail a check for \$40 and include the Race Number, and the name of the rider (can write in the check memo).

2) If you registered for the League and paid \$190 then you are already registered for all 4 races.

3) If you are not registered for the 2009 League, you must register **online** at <http://www.socaldirt.org/register/rider>. A mail in release and payment are also required and a \$20 late fee applies if they are not received by March 3rd.

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES

- Parking is limited at the venue. Try to carpool into the race and limit the number of vehicles each team brings.
- No gasoline generators inside the team pit area, please, and no open fires.
- No dogs off leash please.
- Those petitioning for exceptions to category placement must do so in the required timeframe before the race. Same-day petitions will not be considered.
