**High School: Sunday April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9:15 AM**  
**Castaic Lake SRA, Castaic**

**\*Middle school registration opens Saturday at 1:30 PM.**

**\*High school registration opens Sunday at 7:45 AM.**

**DESCRIPTION:** A tight and twisty course with one main steep climb and repeated short punchy climbs. Plenty of great spectating sections on the grass. Look for a debut of the Curley Que. A feature borrowed from Cyclocross. One high school lap is approximately 5.2 miles with 450 feet of climbing. One middle school lap is approximately 3 miles with 275 feet of climbing. Lap counts below.

**PRE-RIDE:** All middle and high school riders are strongly encouraged to pre-ride the course. Pre-ride is open Saturday from Noon-5:00 PM and Sunday from 7:30-9:00 AM. **Please note: middle school race will be happening on part of the high school course Saturday beginning at 3:00 PM. Please give the right of way to middle school racers and pre-ride between noon-3:00 PM if possible.** Please pass course workers with care.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Highway 5 at Castaic, take the Lake Hughes Road exit heading east. Turn north on Ridge Route Road. Turn east on Castaic Lake Drive and follow directions into park.

**ACCOMODATIONS:** There is no camping AT the race venue. Closest is across the lower lake around 1 mile from the infield, reservations by calling 661.257.4050 x "0" or by visiting the website at <http://reservations.lacounty.gov>. Next is also about 1 mile from the infield at Castaic RV Park: (661)257-3340 <http://www.castaiclakervpark.com>. Third is Valencia Travel Village: (661)257-3333 <http://www.valenciatravelvillage.com> which is about 5 miles from the infield. There are plenty of reasonably priced hotels within a short distance of the race venue. We have reserved two "group camps" up the hill from the race venue. We have them from Friday at noon through Sunday at 11:00 AM. They are primitive (no electricity, hookups, or water) and are first-come first served. You can find all camping options marked on the map. Vehicle entrance fee to Castaic Lake is \$11 per day so carpool or ride bikes in to save \$\$\$.

**MEETINGS:** Middle school course marshal/sweep meeting Saturday at 2:00 PM. High school course marshal/sweep meeting Sunday at 7:45 AM. High school coach meeting Sunday at 8:15 AM.

**FOOD SERVICE:** The "Grilled Cheese Truck" will be on site serving lunch Saturday and breakfast and lunch Sunday.

**NEUTRAL SUPPORT:** Casino Bicycles will be on hand staffing the Neutral Support Zone powered by SRAM. They can provide mechanical assistance prior to your race start.

**REGISTRATION:** All riders need to be "Race Ready" online in the Pit Zone before online registration closes at 11:59 PM on Monday night 03/28/16. "Race Ready" means you have completed your online profile, e-signed your online paperwork, and paid your season fee. **THERE WILL BE NO ON SITE SEASON REGISTRATION AT THE RACE.** If you are "Race Ready" in the Pit Zone you can pay your race registration on site (plus a \$10 late fee). Easiest is to pre-register for your race online. Contact your Team Director to get registered. Independent riders should contact Associate League Director Brandon LaRue at [brandon@socaldirt.org](mailto:brandon@socaldirt.org) for registration information. Each racer will receive a number plate with embedded computer chip TO BE KEPT AND USED ALL SEASON. Replacement plates cost \$10 and are available on site at race registration.
