Tehachapi Race Venue, Tehachapi

***Middle school registration opens Saturday at 1:30 PM. All middle school riders (or their parent/guardian) who are racing for the first time this season OR changing fields must come to registration to declare their field and get their plate.**

DESCRIPTION: A purpose built and challenging course with some hard climbs and some great single track. One high school lap is approximately 6 miles with 650 feet of climbing. **Experienced Middle School Boys and Girls will be racing the high school course at Finals.** One middle school lap is approximately 4 miles with 450 feet of climbing. Lap counts below. **Venue is adjacent to active mining. Respect signage and stay out of closed areas. All areas NORTH of the course are OFF LIMITS.**

PRE-RIDE: All middle and high school riders are strongly encouraged to pre-ride the course. Pre-ride is open Saturday from Noon-5:00 PM and Sunday from 7:30-9:00 AM. **Please note: middle school race will be happening on part of the high school course Saturday beginning at 3:00 PM. Please give the right of way to middle school racers and pre-ride between noon-3:00 PM if possible.** Please pass course workers with care.

DIRECTIONS: From Highway 58 exit at Tehachapi Boulevard. Take Tehachapi Blvd. east approximately 1 mile. Look for race signs and make a left turn over the railroad tracks. Follow signs to the race venue.

ACCOMODATIONS: There is a large amount of primitive (no water, power, or dump; porta-potties available) camping on site. This venue was built by the local IMBA chapter Tehachapi Mountain Trails Association and the Tehachapi HS and Composite MTB teams. In lieu of charging for camping PLEASE go to their tent and make a donation so that they will be able to continue to build and refine the trail system and the SoCal League will be able to race there in the future! A suggested donation of \$20 per camping family would be GREAT! There are local hotels for those not camping. **No open fires or smoking allowed.**

FOOD SERVICE: Red House BBQ will be selling lunch onsite Saturday and breakfast and lunch onsite Sunday. Mmmmmmm GOOD!

NEUTRAL SUPPORT: Casino Bicycles will be on hand staffing the Neutral Support Zone powered by SRAM. They can provide mechanical assistance prior to your race start.

REGISTRATION: All riders need to be "Race Ready" online in the Pit Zone before online registration closes at 11:59 PM on Monday night 05/02/16. "Race Ready" means you have completed your online profile, e-signed your online paperwork, and paid your season fee. **THERE WILL BE NO ON SITE SEASON REGISTRATION AT THE RACE.** If you are "Race Ready" in the Pit Zone you can pay your race registration on site (plus a \$10 late fee). Easiest is to pre-register for your race online. Contact your Team Director to get registered. Independent riders should contact Associate League Director Brandon LaRue at brandon@socaldirt.org for registration information. Each racer will receive a number plate with embedded computer chip TO BE KEPT AND USED ALL SEASON. Replacement plates cost \$10 and are available on site at race registration.
