**NOTE: Daylight Savings starts Sunday. "Spring Forward" one hour before bed Saturday night and don't miss your race start!**

**High School: Sunday March 13<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 AM**

**Vail Lake Resort, Temecula**

**\*Middle school registration opens Saturday at 11:00 AM. All middle school riders (and/or parent/guardian) must come to registration to declare their field and get their plate.**

**DESCRIPTION:** Rollercoaster style single track and fast fire road climbs. One high school lap is approximately 5.5 miles with 420 feet of climbing. One middle school lap is approximately 3.3 miles with 290 feet of climbing. Lap counts below.

**PRE-RIDE:** All middle and high school riders are strongly encouraged to pre-ride the course. Pre-ride is open Saturday from Noon-5:00 PM and Sunday from 7:30-9:00 AM. Please note: middle school race will be happening on part of the high school course Saturday beginning at 3:00 PM. Please give the right of way to middle school racers and pre-ride between noon-3:00 PM if possible. Please pass course workers with care.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Highway 15 at Temecula, take highway 79 South 9 miles to Vail Lake Resort.

**ACCOMODATIONS:** Camping at the race venue! The Campsites at Vail Lake are surrounded by shady hundred year old Oak trees and thousands of acres of beautiful desert scenery. Our event will be held adjacent to the Lower Merlot mesa campground area. Contact Vail Lake reservations at (951) 303-0173. Website [www.vaillakeresort.com](http://www.vaillakeresort.com). All sites have full hookups for RV's. There are full amenities for campers including hot showers. There are many hotels within 15 miles of Vail Lake Resort if you are not a camper. The hotels are located off the 15 highway near exits Rancho California and the South 79. There is a \$10 gate fee for all vehicles at Vail, but this is waived for anyone who is camping.

**FOOD SERVICE:** The *Devilicious Food Truck* ([www.Deviliciousfoodtruck.com](http://www.Deviliciousfoodtruck.com)) will be serving lunch Saturday from 11:00 AM - 2:00 PM, Sunday breakfast beginning at 8:00 AM and lunch Sunday through 2:00 PM. The *Happy Camper* bar and restaurant will be open on site Friday and Saturday evenings.

**NEUTRAL SUPPORT:** Casino Bicycles will be on hand staffing the Neutral Support Zone powered by SRAM. They can provide mechanical assistance prior to your race start.

**REGISTRATION:** All riders need to be "Race Ready" online in the Pit Zone before online registration closes at 11:59 PM on Monday night 03/07/16. "Race Ready" means you have completed your online profile, e-signed your online paperwork, and paid your season fee. **THERE WILL BE NO ON SITE SEASON REGISTRATION AT THE RACE.** If you are "Race Ready" in the Pit Zone you can pay your race registration on site (plus a \$10 late fee). Easiest is to pre-register for your race online. Contact your Team Director to get registered. Independent riders should contact Associate League Director Brandon LaRue at [brandon@socaldirt.org](mailto:brandon@socaldirt.org) for registration information. Each racer will receive a number plate with embedded computer chip TO BE KEPT AND USED ALL SEASON. Replacement plates cost \$10 and are available on site at race registration.
