**Cachuma Lake, CA**

Join us Saturday evening from 6-9:00 PM in the attire you think best fitting for a Mountain Bikers Prom. Wear a tux. Don a dinosaur suit. Have fun with it. It's up to you. Be ready to dance! There will be a photo booth, DJ, refreshments, and dessert provided.

**DESCRIPTION:** A purpose-built and challenging out and back course that winds its way through the Cachuma campground. The course features some hard climbs with great views and some seriously fun single and double track. One high school lap is approximately 6 miles with 450 feet of climbing. **Level 3 Middle School Boys and Girls will be racing 2 laps of the high school course at Finals.** One middle school lap is approximately 4.9 miles with 400 feet of climbing. Lap counts below. **The course travels through the Mohawk Camp area. Vehicle traffic will be VERY limited to and from this area during the races. If you are camped in this area be aware that you will not be able to leave until the conclusion of the final race each day.**

**PRE-RIDE:** All riders are strongly encouraged to pre-ride the course. Pre-ride of the whole course is open Saturday from 11:00 AM-2:00 PM and Sunday from 7:30-9:00 AM. **Pre-ride with map and identification.**

**DIRECTIONS:** The venue is located along Highway 154. From Highway 154 exit at the Cachuma Lake Recreation Area signage. Be aware that the road exit comes up very quickly and that there may be a long line, delaying traffic up highway 154, especially in the northbound direction. Upon entering the recreation area the venue is immediately to the right.

**PARKING & ACCOMMODATIONS:** The venue has an abundance of camping that may be booked in advance by visiting the Santa Barbara County Parks booking site. Some special sites are available in the Mohawk Camp area and may be reserved by phone only. To book those sites call and state that you are attending the SoCal League Event. All parking is located along the main camp road past the venue area. Please park at campsites if you have reserved them to allow for day visitors to use the day lots. The lake has a grocery store and gas station, both located along the main camp road.

**FOOD SERVICE:** Food may be purchased at the camp grocery store or at the camp restaurant **"Hook'd Bar and Grill."** There are no other restaurants close by and the camp restaurant is our only allowed option. There will be no food trucks at Finals. It is likely that the camp restaurant will get overwhelmed so please come prepared.

**NEUTRAL SUPPORT:** **Unchained Bicycle Garage** ([www.unchainedbicyclegarage.com](http://www.unchainedbicyclegarage.com) for more info) will be on hand to provide Neutral Support. They can provide mechanical assistance prior to your race start. Please do not abuse Neutral Support! Neutral Support is for emergency fixes of bikes ONLY! Neutral support is NOT a place to bring poorly maintained bikes for free work. If mechanics staffing Neutral Support believe your fix is not an emergency they may contact the Race Director who may have your bike removed

**REGISTRATION:** All riders planning on racing need to be **"Practice Ready"** in the Pit Zone. "Practice Ready" means you have completed your online profile, e-signed your online paperwork, and paid your season fee. If you become practice ready within a week of the race please bring a copy of your confirmation email with you when you come to registration. Race pre-registration closes at 11:59 PM on Tuesday night 04/26/22. If you do not pre-register for the race and are "practice ready" you can register on site for the normal fee plus a \$10 late fee. Easiest is to pre-register for your race online. Contact your Team Director to get registered. Independent riders should contact League Director Brandon La Rue at [brandon@socaldirt.org](mailto:brandon@socaldirt.org) for registration information.

**Please bring checks or cash if registering on-site at a race. Limited cell coverage sometimes makes using credit cards at a race impossible.**

**PODIUMS:** There are multiple things to be aware of with regards to awards at finals. **There will be two podium ceremonies on Sunday afternoon.** Please make sure to stick around for both to ensure that you receive your season overall rewards. Note that Season Overall awards are given to more riders than the typical five in some fields. Leader Jerseys are likely to shift and there are important factors that effect overall standings to consider that may not be extremely obvious. Details on everything you should be aware of are below.

- **INDIVIDUAL FINAL OVERALL SERIES STANDINGS** are based on the top 4 finishes of the 5 race series. This means that after the racing at Finals is complete, the scoring computer tabulates the top 4 scores for each rider's season and drops the lowest score (in some cases this is the lowest finish and in other cases this was a race the rider did not start or did not finish). AFTER the lowest score is dropped — it adds 25 bonus points to any rider that FINISHED all 5 races. It then sorts each field based on those scores. This means that sometimes, a rider who is finishing at or near the top of a field MIGHT end up winning the final LEADER jersey (this is the person who finishes the series in the jersey and is declared the winner of the 2022 SoCal Series in the field they raced in) even if they haven't held it all season. It also means that sometimes riders who haven't been on or near the podium end up moving up based on their consistency. Finally, for the OVERALL individual podiums, the number of awards is based on a fraction of the number of total riders in that field. For example, a field size of 10 riders would be awarded to at least top 3 overall where a field size of 75 riders would be awarded to top 10 overall.
- **TEAM FINAL OVERALL SERIES STANDINGS** are based on adding up all the points awarded to the team at each of the 5 series races. No dropped race.
